By signing the waiver and agreement to hold harmless, you agree to the following:

This is a binding contract between Camp Woof LLC d/b/a Camp Woof (hereafter called "Camp Woof" and the dog owner (hereafter called "Guardian).

Camp Woof will exercise reasonable care to any and all dogs staying at Camp Woof. However, Guardian understands that participation and boarding at Camp Woof is not without some risk. While under the care of Camp Woof, Guardian agrees to be solely responsible for any and all acts of Guardian's dog(s) behavior. Guardian assumes any expenses and liability for injuries to dog(s) and/or persons while at Camp Woof. In addition, Guardian agrees to pay any and all medical and/or veterinary expenses incurred as a result of any injury inflicted by Guardian's dog(s) to another person or dog(s) while under the care of Camp Woof. Guardian gives Camp Woof sole discretion to act on Guardian's behalf in electing whether or not to seek veterinarian care for Guardian's dog(s) at Guardian's expense. Guardian hereby waives and releases Camp Woof, its employees, owners, and agents from any and all claims, while on the grounds or the surrounding area, and resulting from participation at Camp Woof including specifically, but not limited to, any injury or damage resulting from the action to dog(s).

Camp Woof Policies

- All dogs must be spayed or neutered once they reach seven (7) months of age. Dogs that do not meet these requirements may not board or daycare at Camp Woof LLC.
- All dogs should be in general good health, at least three (3) months of age, and must have completed all series of shots prior to registering with Camp Woof. Dogs must not have been exposed to any illnesses within a thirty (30) day period prior to a visit at Camp Woof. We must have a copy of your dog's most recent vaccination records prior to your dog(s) attending daycare or boarding.
- All dogs must be free of fleas and ticks. We reserve the right to treat any dog brought into Camp Woof for fleas and ticks at the expense of the Guardian.
- When boarding your dog(s), we ask that you bring your dogs' usual food to minimize diet disruptions. Otherwise a \$3.50 per meal fee will be charged for food we provide.
- All dogs are required to attend a day of daycare before a boarding reservation can be made. This allows us to determine if your dog's personality and behavior are compatible with our free-roaming playroom environment. This maybe waived by the manager of the facility.
- Camp Woof reserves the right to limit your dog(s) playtime if he/she appears to be overly tired or over-stimulated, and/or exhibit any other behavior(s) that might act as a detriment to your dogs' health and well-being or that of any other dog staying at Camp Woof. Should inappropriate behavior occur, the Camp Woof staff shall manage that behavior as deemed necessary.
- Camp Woof reserves the right to refuse service to any customer or dog(s) at any time for any reason or to restrict any pet from daycare and/or boarding for any reason.
- Daycare packages, boarding packages, bath packages, and brush-out packages are non-refundable and are only transferable to another dog in the same household.
- Boarding requires a reservation. You may pick up or drop off your dog(s) at any time between 7am and 6:00pm. Dogs left for grooming and/or daycare that are not picked up by 7:00 pm will be charge a day of daycare or an associated night of boarding.
- A 24-hour cancellation notice is required for non-holiday boarding reservations. If we do not receive a 24-notice, then one night's boarding fee may be assessed.
- Holiday boarding reservations require a 72-hour cancellation notice. If we do not receive a 72-hour notice, then one night's boarding fee will be assessed. Once a holiday reservation has begun, a fee of \$10/night (per dog) will be assessed if you end up shortening the reservation. A one (1) night deposit will be required for all holiday reservations. This deposit is fully refundable if the reservation is canceled 72-hours ahead of the expected arrival date.
- A \$3.00 per night holiday surcharge will be charged four (4) days before and after the following holidays: New Years Eve, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.
- Prior to your dog(s) leaving our facility, all daycare/boarding/bath and/or incidental charges incurred during your dog's/dogs' visit must be paid in full.
- A credit card number is necessary in order to enroll your dog in daycare or boarding. Your credit card will be charged in the event your dog(s) requires medical attention
- Camp Woof reserves the right to change our policies at any time without prior notice.
- Camp Woof reserves the right to use our Veterinarian of choice for emergency services if we are unable to reach the Guardians or the Guardians Veterinarian.
- Guardian specifically represents that he or she is the sole owner of the pet (which Guardian is delivering to Camp Woof pursuant to this contract), free & clear of all liens and encumbrances.
- Guardian hereby grants the Facility a lien on the Guardians dog(s) for any and all unpaid charges resulting from boarding, day care, grooming, or any other service provided by the facility.
- Guardian expressly agrees that the facilities liability shall in no event exceed the current chattel value if a pets of the same species as the pet delivered by Guardian to the facility pursuant to this contract.
- Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Contract , or breach thereof, or as the result of any claim or controversy involving the alleged negligence by any party to this Contract, shall by arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association.
